with pessoa s work once in lisbon he began a practice of reading a poem from zenith s anthology and responding in whatever mode seemed to click even before his trip however he had become fascinated by air disasters a tv show that tells the story of different plane crashes in each of its episodes these stories as well as the textures and squares of the city he was visiting began to resonate with his concerns and pessoa s and make their way into the book through its inspirations and juxtapositions and its agile shifts of voice and form from meme to fiction to aphorism to screenshot to lyric the book leads us to reckon with the most universal questions what is the self what holds the self multiple fragmented performative increasingly algorithmically controlled constantly under threat of death intact and aloft
