## **diltiazem dosing strategies in the management of atrial *Apr 01 2024***

according to the american college of cardiology foundation american heart association and european society of cardiology acc aha esc 2006 guidelines for the management of patients with atrial fibrillation the recommended diltiazem dosing should be 0 25 mg kg bolus followed by an intravenous iv drip of 5 15 mg hour

## **acute management of atrial fibrillation part i rate and *Feb 29 2024***

diltiazem cardizem 15 to 20 mg iv over 2 minutes may repeat in 15 minutes 5 to 15 mg per hour by continuous iv infusion convenient easy to titrate to heart

start drip at 5mg hr consider addition 30mg po ir diltiazem q6 hours or home dose to reduce need for drip drip can be titrated to 15mg hr with re bolus of 0 25mg kg with each increase

## ***adult iv push infusion guidelines for select medications Mar 20 2023***

0.25 mg/kg iv push 10-60 minutes before start of pci maintenance dose 0.125 mcg/kg/min continuous iv infusion maximum 10 mcg/min for 12-24 hours bolus dose iv push rate over 1 minute vital signs every 15 minutes x 4 every 30 minutes x 2 then every 1 hour or per patient's condition
