question what makes these so called online communities so valuable the answer to this question may be surprising to many people the deployed technologies are more or less the same as 6 years ago but what all these new sites share is a new approach to creating things user generated content in the jargon the internet is no longer about corporations telling users what to do think or buy it is about the content people create themselves participation not publishing is the keyword in online communities people s private lives and experiences dominate conversations sex destinies misfortune and luck holidays pets sports music and lots of everyday life more people use the internet to participate in online communities than to make purchase transactions 84 of internet users
