policies social norms et al are morally right or wrong permissible or impermissible praiseworthy or condemnable etc no matter when where or by whom they are performed in order to provide a firm conceptual basis for such judgments the book develops a theory of moral truth based on a theory of moral facts the account of moral truth and moral facts is further grounded on a theory of moral properties in short the book develops a theory of moral realism roughly the view that there are indeed non relative first order moral truths the second half of the book is aimed at answering the
