Eden's Everdark 1956-11-10 the philokalia is a foundational collection of texts written between the fourth and the fifteenth centuries by spiritual masters of the orthodox christian tradition first published in greek in 1782 translated into slavonic and later into russian the philokalia has exercised an influence far greater than that of any book other than the bible in the recent history of the orthodox church and it continues to be read more and more widely only a selection of texts from the philokalia has hitherto been available in english this is the first complete translation into english from the original greek in five volumes the first of which was published by faber in 1979 it is concerned with themes of universal importance how we may develop our inner powers and awake from

illusion how we may overcome fragmentation and achieve spiritual wholeness how we may attain the life of contemplative stillness and union with god as in the first four volumes the editors have provided introductory notes to each of the writers a glossary of key terms and a detailed index

Billboard 2007 the bible teems with nonhuman life from its opening pages with god's creation of animals on the same day and out of the same earth as humans to its closing apocalyptic scenes of horses riding out of the sky animals are adam's companions noah's shipmates and elijah's saviors they are at the center of ancient israel's religious life as sacrifices and yet as job discovers beyond human dominion it is an animal that saves balaam from certain death by an angel's hand and an animal that carries jesus into jerusalem the creator declares all of them good at the beginning and since the apostle paul writes of god's eternal purposes for all things on earth they are somehow part of a hoped for eschatological restoration so why are animals so often ignored in christian moral discourse in its theological thinking and faith motivated praxis human centeredness typically results in the complete erasure of the nonhuman this book argues that this exclusion of animals is problematic for those who see the bible as authoritative for the religious life instead biblical literature bears witness to a more inclusive understanding of moral duty and faith motivated largesse that extends also to eden's other residents

empire kellner s is a thoroughly habsburg jewish story spanning east and west and shaped by the empire s history politics and culture he was a singular character a galician jew at home in vienna and in czernowitz eyes towards zion yet content also in london and never more so than when absorbed in the minutiae of shakespeare s texts kellner s world was destroyed twice over habsburg austria came to an end in 1918 east central european jewry in 1945 this biography recovers at least part of what was lost
