how true a representation of reality can a photograph provide does the reproduction of a photograph affect its value as authentic or not from a photograph examines these questions in the light of the early scientific periodical press exploring how the perceived veracity of a photograph its use as scientific evidence and the technologies developed for printing it were intimately connected before photomechanical printing processes became widely used in the 1890s scientific periodicals were unable to reproduce photographs and instead included these photographic images as engravings with the label from a photograph consequently every image was mediated by a human interlocutor introducing the potential for error and misinterpretation rather than reading photographs in the context of where or how they were taken this book emphasises the importance of understanding how photographs are reproduced it explores and compares the value of photography as authentic proof in both popular and scientific publications during this period of significant technological developments and a growing readership three case studies investigate different uses of photography in print using pigeons to transport microphotographs during the franco prussian war the debate surrounding the development of instantaneous photography and finally the photographs taken of the transit of venus in 1874 unseen by the human eye but captured on camera and made accessible to the public through the periodical addressing a largely overlooked area of photographic history from a photograph makes an important contribution to this interdisciplinary research and will be of interest to historians of photography print culture and science

in an unscientific era when maps were rarities how did ancient romans envisage their far flung empire this was done by various means for certain including with the aid of an ingenious type of portable sundial that has barely attracted notice as the romans understood before the first century bce to track the passage of the sun across the sky hour by hour one needed to know one s latitude and the time of year and that furthermore sundials did not have to be fixed objects these portable instruments crafted in bronze were adjustable for the changes of latitude to be expected on long journeys say for instance from britain to spain or from alexandria to rome or even on a mediterranean tour for convenient reference these sundials incorporated lists of twenty to thirty names of cities or regions each with its specific latitude one of the insights of roman portable sundials is that the choice of locations offers unique clues to the mental world map and self identity of individuals able to visualize rome s vast empire latitudinally the sixteen such sundials known to date share common features but designers also vied to create enhancements comparison with modern calculations shows that often the latitudes listed are incorrect in which case the sundial may not perform at its best but then the nature of romans time consciousness or lack of it must be taken into consideration richard talbert suspects that owners might prize these sundials not so much for practical use but rather as prestige objects attesting to scientific awareness as well as imperial mastery of time and space in retrospect they may be

seen as roman precursors to comparable islamic and european instruments from the middle ages onwards and even to today s luxury watches which display eye catching proof of their purchasers wealth sophistication and cosmopolitanism richly enhanced with detailed photographs line drawings maps a gazetteer and a table of latitudes and locations roman portable sundials brings these overlooked gadgets out of the shadows at last to reveal their hitherto untapped layers of meaning

a comprehensive study of lessing s religious thought although only one aspect of gotthold ephraim lessing s diverse oeuvre his religious thought had a significant influence on thinkers such as kant hegel kierkegaard and present day liberal protestant theologians his thought is particularly difficult to assess however because it is found largely in a series of essays reviews critical studies polemical writings and commentary on theological texts beyond these his correspondence and a few fragmentary essays unpublished during his lifetime we have his famous drama of religious toleration nathan the wise and his philosophical historical sketch the education of the human race in these scattered texts lessing challenged the full range of theological views in the enlightenment from protestant orthodoxy with its belief in biblical inerrancy to a radical naturalism which rejected both the concept of a divine revelation and the historically based claims of christianity to be one as well as virtually everything in between since he refused to identify himself with

any of these parties lessing was an enigmatic figure and a central question from his time to today is where he stood on the issue of the truth of the christian religion now back in print and with the addition of two supplementary essays henry e allison s book argues that despite appearances lessing was not merely an eclectic thinker or intellectual provocateur but a serious philosopher of religion who combined a basically spinozistic conception of god with a sophisticated pluralistic conception of religious truth inspired by leibniz
